



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

**UNIVERSITAS MUHAMMADIYAH JAKARTA
(UMJ) - INDONESIA**

And

**ABHINAV SHIKSHAN SANSTHA, NAWALEWADI
TAL.AKOLE, DIST.AHMEDNAGAR (MH) INDIA**

This memorandum of understanding is made on 23/08/2022

Between

UNIVERSITAS MUHAMMADIYAH JAKARTA, a private University established under Central Board of Muhammadiyah whose address is at Jalan KH Ahmad Dahlan, Cireundeu, Ciputat, Tangerang Selatan, Indonesia (herein after referred to as "**UMJ**") and will include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns on the other part;

AND

ABHINAV SHIKSHAN SANSTHA, NAWALEWADI, a private institution of higher and innovative learning Incorporated and having its correspondence address at **TAL.AKOLE, DIST.AHMEDNAGAR (MH) INDIA**, India (herein after referred to as "**ABHINAV**") and will include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns on the one part;



UMJ and **ABHINAV** shall hereinafter be referred to singularly as "the Party" and collectively as "the Parties".

WHEREAS :

- A. **UMJ** is an established private university in Jakarta - Indonesia which strives to enhance and strengthen its tertiary-level education training in a wide spectrum of academic disciplines via various collaborative arrangements with other parties.
- B. **ABHINAV** is an established private Institution in Maharashtra-India which strives to enhance and strengthen its education and community service and has taken various initiative to achieve university research and its educational excellence and had entered into various collaborative arrangements with other parties to enhance networking
- C. The Parties are desirous of entering into this Memorandum of Understanding to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

THE PARTIES HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING as follows:

ARTICLE I

OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each Party's country, will endeavor to strengthen, promote and develop on a basis of direct cooperation and collaboration in the field of research, education and in training programs on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.



ARTICLE II
AREAS OF COOPERATION

1. Each Party will, subject to the laws, rules, regulation and national policies from time to time in force, governing the subject matter in their respective countries, endeavor to take necessary steps to encourage and promote cooperation in the following areas:
 - a) exchange of publications, information, and other educational and research materials;
 - b) collaboration of faculty and research scholars;
 - c) cooperation in the implementation of student internship, study abroad and exchange programs;
 - d) joint research in the field of medicine and health science, sciences and technology, economic, management, language and communication, counseling and social work;
 - e) professional meetings for education and research;
 - f) faculty exchange;
 - g) student exchange;
 - h) Community service;
 - i) staff and faculty development; and
 - j) program exchanges for university management and advancement
 - k) any other areas of co-operation to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.
2. For the purpose of implementing the co-operation in respect of any area stated in paragraph 1, the Parties will enter into a legally binding agreement subject to terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon by the Parties including clauses on "confidentiality", "suspension", "protection of intellectual property rights" and "settlement of dispute".



ARTICLE III

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

1. This Memorandum of Understanding will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other.
2. Each Party shall bear its own cost and expenses in relation to this Memorandum of Understanding, unless otherwise specifically mentioned through a separate correspondence.

ARTICLE IV

EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

ARTICLE V

NO AGENCY

Nothing contained herein is to be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organization of any kind between the Parties or so to constitute either Party as the agent of the other.

ARTICLE VI

ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION

1. This Memorandum of Understanding will come into effect on the date of signing and will remain in effect for a period of **five (5) years**.
2. This Memorandum of Understanding may be extended for a further period as may be agreed in writing by the Parties.



ARTICLE VII

NOTICES

Any communication under this Memorandum of Understanding will be in writing in the English language and delivered personally or sent by registered mail to the address or sent to the electronic mail address of **UMJ** and **ABHINAV**, as the case may be, shown below or to such other address or electronic mail address as either Party may have notified the sender and shall, unless otherwise provided herein, be deemed to be duly given or made when delivered to the recipient at such address or electronic mail address which is duly acknowledged:

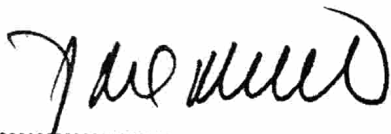

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Abhinav Education Society, Akole, India

And

Phranakhon Si Ayutthaya Rajabhat University, the Kingdom of Thailand

Abhinav Education Society, Akole, India and Phranakhon Si Ayutthaya Rajabhat University, the Kingdom of Thailand agree to enter into a formal collaborative agreement based on a foundation of trust for the mutual benefit and development of the two parties and the promotion of international understanding and goodwill.

1. Abhinav Education Society, Akole, India and Phranakhon Si Ayutthaya Rajabhat University will jointly develop some or all of the following activities based on their respective academic and educational needs:
 - a. exchange of research materials, publications and information;
 - b. development and operation of joint academic programs;
 - c. organization of joint research programs;
 - d. exchange of lecturers;
 - e. exchange of students;
 - f. exchange of administrative and other non-academic staffs;
 - g. development of common curricula in areas of mutual interest;
 - h. co-operation in the recruitment of students to our two parties;
 - i. cultural collaboration.
2. The implementation of exchange based on this agreement shall be separately negotiated and determined by both parties.
3. Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either party, nor will any constraints or financial obligations be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the agreement.



4. The terms of this agreement is subject to revision or renewal by the mutual written consent of both parties. It is also understood that either party may terminate the agreement at any time, although such action will only be taken after mutual consultation in order to avoid any possible inconvenience to all parties.
5. The agreement is valid from the date of signature of all parties listed below, for period of five years, and may be renewed before the expiration date by agreement of both parties.
6. This agreement is effective when the representatives of both parties have signed and dated the document.

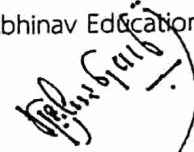

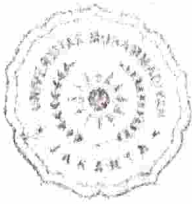
